

Special Term/information for DUA competition participants

1. For Dua competition children should memorise all the Duas and its **meanings** listed to their group, they will be requested to recite by the judges/supervisors randomly on any Dua and its meanings provided to their group. (Special notes: For this year Dua competition both the arabic recitation and its meaning will be assessed together. The competitors will be clearly expected to read out the meaning in English after the Arabic part of the Dua)
2. Children will be assessed on Memory, Recitation, Thajweed, meaning in English and confidence.
3. Judges or Examiners will decide how many Duas to be recited within the maximum time limit given to each group in the charts in the main page.

GROUP 1

01. KALIMAH TAYYIBAH

لَا إِلَهَ إِلَّا اللَّهُ مُحَمَّدٌ رَّسُولُ اللَّهِ

There is no God besides Allah; Muhammad (PBUH) is the messenger of Allah. (Bukhari and Muslim)

02. DUAS FOR PARENTS

رَبِّ ارْحَمْهُمَا كَمَا رَبَّيْتَنِي صَغِيرًا

*"O Allah! Give Your Mercy on them as they had mercy on me when I was small."
(Al-Quraan S.17, V.2)*

03. FOR INCREASE IN KNOWLEDGE

رَبِّ زِدْنِي عِلْمًا

*O My Allah, Increase me in knowledge.
(Sura Ta'ha, S.20 V.114)*

04. WHEN AN EVIL THOUGHT COMES TO MIND

أَعُوذُ بِاللَّهِ مِنَ الشَّيْطَانِ الرَّجِيمِ
أَمَنْتُ بِاللَّهِ وَرُسُلِهِ

*I seek the protection of Allah from the accursed devil. I believe in Allah and His messengers.
(Muslim, Vol. 1, Pg.79)*

05. BEFORE EATING

بِسْمِ اللَّهِ وَبَرَكَاتِهِ

*In the name of Allah and the blessings of Allah.
(Hakim and Baihaqi)*

06. BEFORE SLEEPING

اللَّهُمَّ بِاسْمِكَ أَمُوتُ وَأَحْيِي

*O Allah, with Your name do I die and live.
(Thirmidhi, Vol. 2, Pg.178)*

GROUP 2

01. WHEN AN EVIL THOUGHT COMES TO MIND

أَعُوذُ بِاللَّهِ مِنَ الشَّيْطَانِ الرَّجِيمِ
أَمَنْتُ بِاللَّهِ وَرَسُولِهِ

I seek the protection of Allah from the accursed devil. I believe in Allah and His messengers.

(Muslim, Vol. 1, Pg.79)

02. KALIMAH SHAHAADAH

أَشْهَدُ أَنْ لَا إِلَهَ إِلَّا اللَّهُ وَأَشْهَدُ أَنَّ
مُحَمَّدًا عَبْدُهُ وَرَسُولُهُ

I bear witness that there is no God besides Allah and I bear witness that Muhammad (PBUH) is His servant and messenger (Bukhari)

03. AFTER EATING

الْحَمْدُ لِلَّهِ الَّذِي أَطْعَمَنِي هَذَا
وَرَزَقَنِيهِ مِنْ غَيْرِ حَوْلٍ مِنِّي وَلَا
قُوَّةٍ

All praise is due to Allah Who has given me food to eat and provided it without any endeavour on my part or any power (Abu Dawud and Tirmidhi)

04. DUAS FOR DISTRESS, WORRY AND GRIEF

رَبَّنَا آتِنَا فِي الدُّنْيَا حَسَنَةً وَفِي الْآخِرَةِ حَسَنَةً وَقِنَا عَذَابَ النَّارِ

Our Lord! Give us in this world that which is good and in the Hereafter that which is good, and save us from the torment of the Fire!” (Qur’aan: 2:201)

05. WHEN AWAKENING

الْحَمْدُ لِلَّهِ الَّذِي أَحْيَانَا بَعْدَ مَا أَمَاتَنَا وَإِلَيْهِ
النُّشُورُ

*All praise is due to Allah who has given us life after death and to Him is the return after death.
(Bukhaari)*

06. WHILST MAKING WUDHU

اَللّٰهُمَّ اغْفِرْ لِيْ ذَنْبِيْ وَوَسِّعْ لِيْ فِيْ دَارِيْ
وَ بَارِكْ لِيْ فِيْ رِزْقِيْ

O Allah, forgive my sins and grant me abundance in my home and blessings in my livelihood.

(Nasai)

07. AFTER DRINKING MILK

اَللّٰهُمَّ بَارِكْ لَنَا فِيْهِ وَزِدْنَا مِنْهُ

O Allah, grant us blessings and abundance in it (the milk).

(Tirmidhi)

08. WHEN A LOSS OCCURS

اِنَّا لِلّٰهِ وَ اِنَّا اِلَيْهِ رَاجِعُوْنَ

Surely we belong to Allah and to Him is our return.

(Muslim)
